

GrantEd's *On Track* seven coaching options are underpinned by our Research Impact Strategy Model™ shown below.

Research Impact Strategy Model™

Programs

Program

1. On Track – Advance

With a focus primarily on helping researchers and academics identify their past track record accomplishments and plan for future success, this program includes a series of online seminars (self-paced), a live group seminar and three x ~two-hour 1:1 individual coaching sessions via videoconference over six months with a GrantEd coach. This program aims to support researchers and academics to develop a clear narrative and focus to help them achieve their professional aspirations.

2. On Track – Promotion

With a focus on supporting individual researchers to develop a promotion application, this program includes two x 1-hour sessions via videoconference with a GrantEd coach, and editorial support of up to two drafts of the person's promotion application.

3. On Track – Fellowship

With a focus primarily on preparing to develop a competitive fellowship application (such as an ARC DECRA or NHMRC Investigator Grant), this program includes three x 1-hour sessions via videoconference with a GrantEd coach, benchmarking support, gap analysis and project conceptualisation support. Ideally conducted well prior to development of the actual application, this program does not include any grant writing or review support, rather acts as the planning phase prior to these activities.

4. On Track – Advisory

With a focus primarily on providing a sounding board for researchers who are considering applying for a major grant, such as a category 1 grant, this advisory discussion, held with a senior advisor from GrantEd, will explore the potential options, track record requirements and project ideas. It will assist researchers to make strategic decisions about their grant development activities.

5. On Track – Explore

With a focus primarily on research planning, this program includes two x 1-hour sessions via videoconference with a GrantEd coach. This program enables the researcher to develop a clear narrative related to their research focus and develop a plan of activities designed to help them identify and achieve their research goals.

6. On Track – Project

With a focus primarily on building capability in developing grants and proposals, this program includes three x 1-hour sessions via videoconference with a GrantEd coach. This program is suitable for researchers planning a project grant such as ARC Linkage or NHMRC Ideas Grant. This program can be run with a small group as well as individually. Ideally conducted well prior to development of the actual application, this program does not include any grant writing or review support, rather acts as the planning phase prior to these activities.

7. On Track – Major Initiative

GrantEd's major initiative incubator program brings together high-potential groups of ~4-5 researchers to discuss and develop research and engagement activities related to planning a competitive application for a large scheme such as an ARC Industrial Transformation Training Centre (ITTC), NHMRC Centre of Research Excellence, or MRFF. The group will meet via videoconference with a GrantEd grants advisor four times for two hours at a time. Ideally conducted well prior to development of the actual application, this program does not include any grant writing or review support, rather acts as the planning phase prior to these activities.




